Our next Poultry and Smallholders Sale at Truro Market will be held on Saturday 12th May 2018 and the sale will commence at 10am.

(SUBJECT TO NO FURTHER BIRD FLU RESTRICTIONS)

We are inviting entries of livestock and deadstock of interest to smallholders including pigs, goats, ponies, plants, garden equipment and any other items of interest.

The sale will continue to focus on the well-established poultry section, but we hope that the opportunity to offer additional varied lots will be of further interest enhancing these sales.

In the Poultry Section, we will **not** accept single cock birds and would encourage vendors to enter pure bred poultry and game in pairs or trios although inferior cocks have a detrimental affect on the value of pullets and young hens which often sell better as laying or breeding birds.

We have a maximum of 300 cages and entries will close as soon as capacity has been reached. Therefore if you have entries we would be obliged if you would complete and return the attached form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. The form **must** be returned to our offices by **Thursday 3rd May 2018** to allow sufficient time to properly advertise the items.

In order to aid the sale we produce a catalogue and therefore require full descriptions.

Entry Forms will be returned to vendors in the week before the sale with lot numbers allocated to entries of poultry only. Other live animals and deadstock will be lotted on the morning of sale.

For Poultry entries, please indicate in the box provided against each lot the size of cage required. We have 240 standard 18" square cages (for bantams and standard fowl) and 64 larger 24" square cages (for large fowl only). Vendors are limited to a total of 20 cages each.

Will vendors please note that poultry, animals and all items of deadstock **must** be brought to the Sheep Section at Truro Livestock Market between **7.30am and 9.00am** on the day of the sale for penning and lotting.

Entries **must** be delivered to the Market on **SATURDAY 12TH MAY** between **7.30am and 9am**. The sale is held in the Sheep Section and will commence at **10am** with deadstock/equipment and eggs followed by poultry and live animals.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. The Auctioneers will not accept individual cock birds. Vendors are encouraged to enter pure bred poultry and game in Pairs or Trios although inferior cocks have a detrimental affect on the value of pullets and young hens which often sell better as laying or breeding birds.
2. Vendors' commission on poultry is 15% of the sale price plus VAT subject to a minimum charge of £2 per lot except on hatching eggs and small mammals. Vendors' commission on the sale of all other livestock and deadstock is 10% of the sale price plus VAT subject to a minimum charge of £1 per lot.
3. Where the vendor sets a reserve price for poultry which is not reached, the Auctioneers reserve the right to charge a penning fee of £2. Any reserves must be clearly stated on the Entry Form otherwise all items will be sold without reserve. It is the vendor's sole responsibility to check with the Sales Office before leaving the sale that all items subject to a reserve have been sold. The responsibility for any unsold items remains with the vendor after they have been offered for sale.
4. Hatching Eggs. All hatching eggs are entered on the understanding that vendors in good faith sell as being pure bred and fertile.
5. For Poultry the following terms are deemed to apply to vendors' descriptions. Where males are wrongly described as females the Auctioneers reserve the right to make an allowance or full refund to purchasers at the vendors' expense.

For Chickens, Bantams etc

Pair - Male & 1 Female
Trio - Male & 2 Females
Two - 2 Females
Three - 3 Females

For Ducks/Geese

Pair - Drake & 1 Duck / Gander & 1 Goose
Trio - Drake & 2 Ducks / Gander & 2 Geese
Otherwise:
Two, Three etc *please specify drake(s)/duck(s)*
