NORTH CORNWALL PROPERTY AUCTION

Lodge & Thomas have seen recent Auction success with a land sale in a sought after part of North Cornwall.



19.3 acres (7.8 hectares) of Grade III arable land in the hamlet of Trelights, near the famous village of Port Isaac, was offered for sale by Auction on Friday 8th July. The Auction was held close to the land, in the conservatory dining room of the beautiful Longcross Hotel which allowed the large gathering of onlookers to look out on the spectacular coastal scenery in this part of Cornwall. With some 60 or 70 gathered, the land was offered for sale as a single block of arable land that has been used for growing cereals for a number of years. The land is laid out in two fields, and has the benefit of a mains water supply.

Offered at a guide of £160,000 the bidding soon gathered pace with a good number of interested local farmers in attendance as well as non-farming people and those from further afield. The hammer eventually fell at a purchase price of £220,000 equivalent to approximately £11,400 per acre and was sold to a local farmer seeking to acquire additional farmland.

Auctioneer Ross Collins, Associate Partner at Lodge & Thomas, was very pleased with the result proving that there continues to be good demand for agricultural land across Cornwall.
