One copy is for the retention of yourself as purchaser, the other is to be signed and sent to Defra. As before, we are happy to send off this half of the movement licence for you if you sign it on collection from the Sheep Office. If not, the new address to post your signed movement licences to is:- Animal Reporting and Movement Service (ARAMS), SouthWestern, PO Box 6299, Milton Keynes, MK10 1ZQ within 3 days.

Vendors may continue to use up their stock of old-style sheep movement licences, however we do have new-style forms available at our Sheep Office or contact SouthWestern as above. The "*Food Chain Information (FCI)*" and "*Total number of animals*" sections **must** be completed. It is essential that vendors of prime lambs and hogs who are Farm Assured use their Farm Assurance stickers on their movement licence – **NO STICKER = NO FARM ASSURANCE!!**
