TRACTOR SCAMS 2013

- Devon and Somerset Trading Standards have had their attention drawn to fraudulent trading activity concerning the sale of tractors.
- Aim for farmers to be extra vigilant when making purchases of farm equipment especially tractors that seem to be very reasonably priced.
- Scam seen in several guises.
- eBay sales – fraudsters hijacking legitimate eBay accounts and putting correspondence surrounding the sale through a private email address and bank account.
- eBay sales – a fraudulent eBay account being set up using details of legitimate companies who do not trade on eBay in order to give the buyer a false sense of security. The legitimate company having no knowledge of their credentials being used.
- Adverts placed in trusted farming and agricultural publications. The main hook being the very reasonable price of the tractor accompanied or unaccompanied by the credentials of a recognised supplier. Money is paid in to the fraudsters bank account and delivery is arranged but the goods never arrive.
- Adverts placed on agricultural internet trading sites for tractors that do not exist. Initial correspondence of emails going back and forth followed by the fraudster asking for funds to be transferred via a bank transfer.
- Advice – be as sure as you can be that the trader you are dealing with exists. Where possible check sort codes of bank accounts against geographical information and any area dialling codes of phone numbers match addresses given.
- Look at genuine pictures of the farm machinery being advertised. Does the model detailed in the advert exist? Does the picture match the picture in the advert? The fraudster may have mis-matched the internet generated photo they are using with the model that they are claiming to have for sale.
- If dealing on eBay it is advisable to go through their buyer/seller contact channels rather than emailing any private email addresses given by the seller. Paypal can offer greater protection to the consumer than wilfully making a bank transfer.
