“YOU STILL HAVE 60 DAYS TO MOVE”

Amended TB Movement Regulations

Cattle Moving From TB Free Herds

1. From 1st January cattle moving from herds which are currently free of TB **will continue to have 60 days in which to move** following a clear annual or pre-movement test.

Cattle Moving From TB Restricted Herds

1. From 1st January cattle moving to an “Orange” Market are only permitted to be purchased by a slaughterhouse, the occupier of an AFU or licensed back to the herd of origin. Following a clear pre-movement TB test, cattle can be moved to such an “Orange” Market for up to 90 days (60 days increased to 90 days).
2. From 1st January cattle moved to any premises other than slaughter or AFU, from TB Restricted herds, will have to do so within 30 days of a clear TB test (60 days reduced to 30 days).

Comprising: 55 in-milk and/or in-calf cows and heifers together with 15 bulling and younger heifers and calves.

This is a small herd of both Friesian Holstein and British Friesian dairy cattle the majority of which are home bred with some purchased from other recent local dispersals.

The annual herd average is about 5,000 litres with butterfat 3.96%, protein 3.17% and annual cell count of 93.

Individual cell counts will be obtained for the milking animals and yields will be given after home weighings.

The cows are kept on a low cost system, cubicle housed running in and out over winter, fed on grass, grass silage and cake in parlour and milked twice daily in a Herringbone parlour.

The cows are vaccinated for Leptospirosis and there has been no known Johne's disease.

With 30 1st to 4th calvers, 20 are recent calvers with 12 due shortly and others during the summer, AI'd either to Holsteins Tennyson and Hayden or to AA or BB beef bulls.

The younger animals include 5 in-calf heifers to AA, 2 bulling heifers and yearling heifers and calves.
